

## Wyoming Licensing Process 8-13-2009

### Company:

- Must register with the State of Wyoming Electrical Safety Division.
- Must employ at least 1 person licensed, by state test, as **“LV Tech TV & Satellite 90 Volts”**.
- May use employees or subcontractors following process below.
- Company is responsible for ensuring licensing compliance and maintains documentation showing such.

### New internal hire comes on board

- Must fill out Apprentice Application for State of Wyoming on first day of employment.
- Must complete training and testing to obtain SBCA Certification.
- Tech is issued a certificate from SBCA.
- Copy of SBCA certificate is sent to State of Wyoming.
- Tech is issues a license to work as satellite technician in Wyoming.

### New sub-contractor comes on board

- Must present valid license for State of Wyoming on first day of employment.
- Sub-contractor can not operate under company license.
- Sub-contractor can not be an apprentice under company license.

**Apprentice License:** The apprentice license is valid for 1 year or until September 1st. Each apprentice technician shall reregister prior to September 1 of each year.

**Initial Fee: \$20.00**

**Renewal Fee: \$20.00**

**Technician License:** The technician license is valid for 3 years, renewing on July 1<sup>st</sup> of every 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

**Initial Fee: \$100.00**

**Renewal Fee: \$50.00**

**LV Tech TV & Satellite 90 Volts Exam:** The LV Tech TV & Satellite 90 Volts exam is through ICC.

**Exam Fee: \$100.00**
